



DREDGE & FILL CHECKLIST

Include with application:

- A plat of the property on which the work will take place. On the plat, sketch the proposed locations of retaining wall, boat slip, excavation activity proposed, erosion controls, etc. This sketch must be of sufficient detail to fully describe the proposed work.
- Evidence of ownership of property on which the requested work will take place (warranty deed or tax records) or written permission from the owner for the applicant to perform the requested work.
- If submitting written permission from the owner for the work to be performed, evidence of their ownership must be submitted (warranty deed or tax records).
- A description of the type and quantity of dredged material (if any), in cubic yards, to be removed from the site. Indicate how dredged areas will be stabilized (e.g. earth slope at 3 horizontal to 1 vertical, sheet piling, concrete/stone retaining wall, etc.)
- A description of the type and quantity of fill material, in cubic yards, to be placed below the normal waterline. (Include in this estimate any material that will be placed below the normal water level to build a retaining wall, boat slip, etc.)
- A description of the plans for the disposal of any dredged material.
- Location Map or driving instructions to the site. If the site is located near Lake Travis, include driving instructions from Austin. If the site is located near the Upper Highland Lakes, include driving instructions from Marble Falls.
- A copy of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers application. (Mail the original directly to the Corps.) If covered by a nationwide permit, include the permit number and a copy of the pre-construction notice, if applicable.
