

I can save water

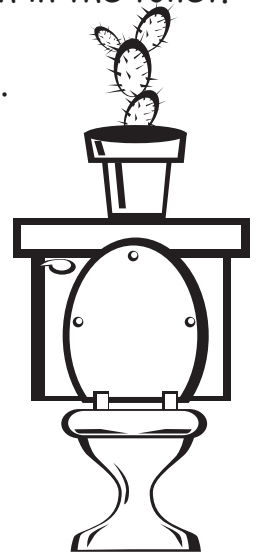
In my kitchen I can...

- fill and plug the sink to wash dishes rather than letting the water run.
- turn on the dishwasher only when it is full.
- keep a bottle of cold water in the fridge.
- run the clothes washer only when it is full.



In my bathroom I can...

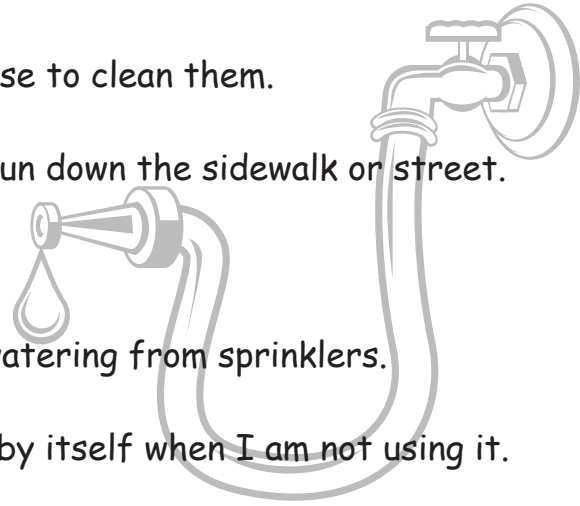
- take a 5 minute shower.
- take a bath with the tub $\frac{1}{2}$ full.
- turn off the water when I brush my teeth.
- use the waste basket and never throw trash in the toilet.
- help my family fix leaky faucets and toilets.



I can save water

In my yard I can...

- sweep the sidewalk and driveway rather than using a hose to clean them.
- sprinklers only water plants and grass, don't let water run down the sidewalk or street.
- water my plants only when they need it.
- learn about native Texas plants that don't need extra watering from sprinklers.
- use a nozzle at the end of my hose so that it turns off by itself when I am not using it.
- plant a tree in my yard to make shade so my plants need less water.
- help my family put mulch around my plants to keep their roots cool and moist.
