Background LCRA constructed the system to meet the needs of residential growth and to alleviate the existing overloaded wastewater system serving the federal prison. A portion of the effluent is used to irrigate coastal Bermuda grass and is not discharged into the surface water supply. LCRA has expanded the system and is permitted to discharge a high quality effluent into Piney Creek. Bastrop Independent School District (BISD) constructed an approach main to serve Lost Pines Elementary School.
