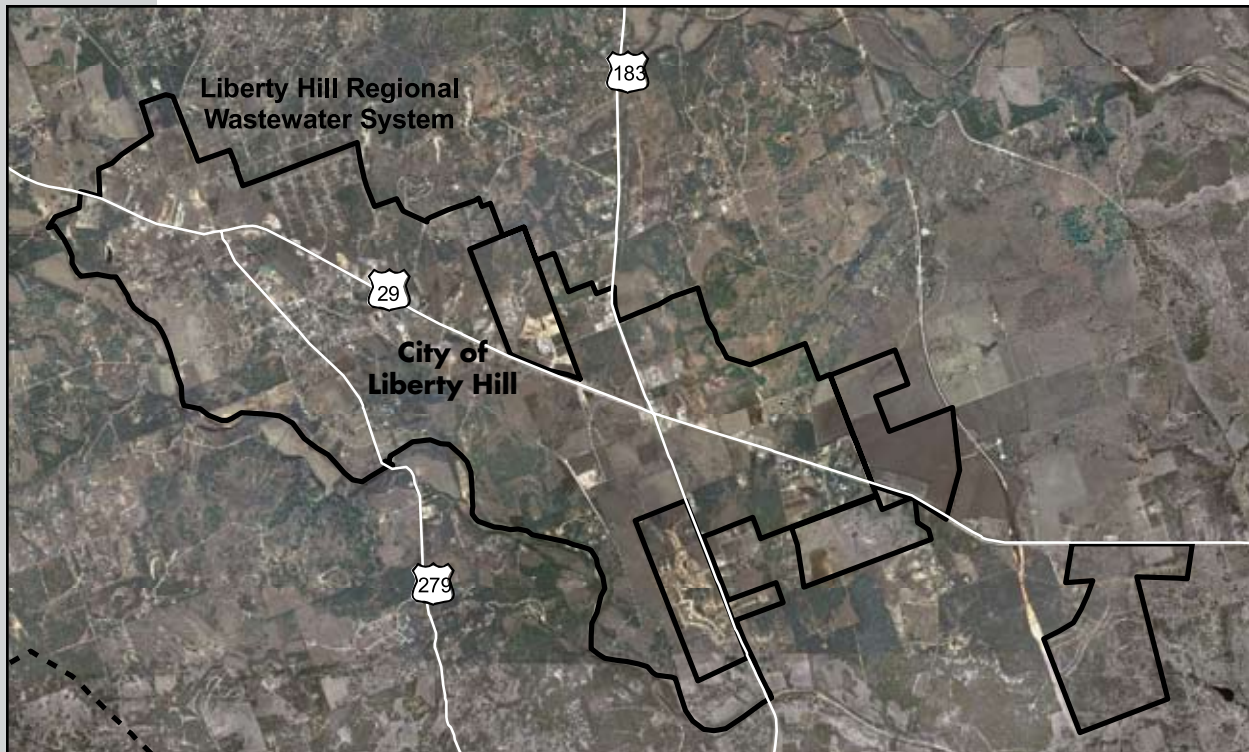

The Brazos River Authority operates it. Although growth in this area has been slow, the system continues to grow and development of new subdivisions continues.
