

Southeast Region

The Southeast Region has seven wastewater treatment systems, two water treatment systems, and a raw water delivery system.

Expansion of the Camp Swift Regional Wastewater System was completed in FY 2008. Effluent from the plant can either be used to irrigate adjacent agricultural lands or discharged to Piney Creek.



LCRA has operated the Elgin Wastewater System since 1997.

The Camp Swift Wastewater Treatment System, a portion of which is pictured, serves the Federal Corrections Institute, Texas Army National Guard, M.D. Anderson Animal Science Center and residents of the Camp Swift area.
