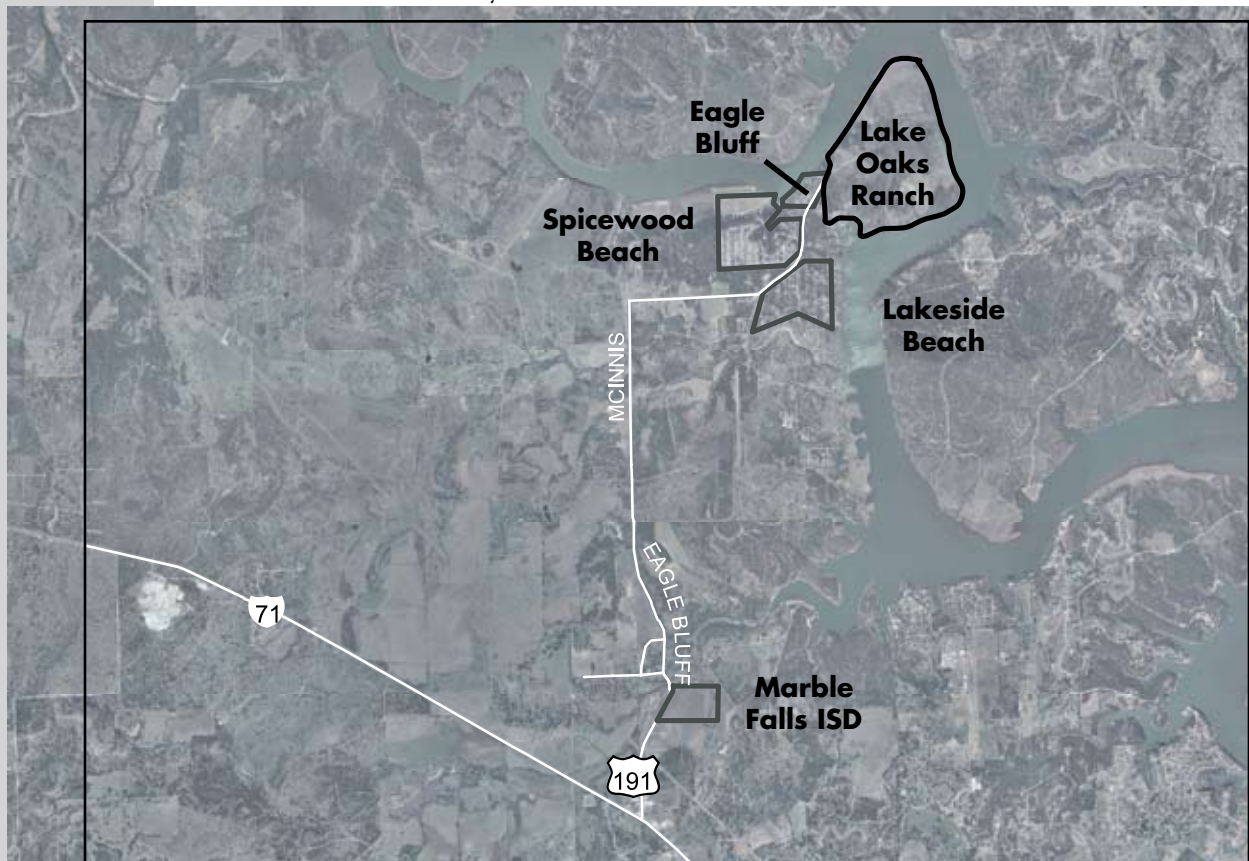

Background The Spicewood Beach Water System, located on the upper reaches of Lake Travis, was acquired by LCRA because the communities wanted help with their aging infrastructure and system operations. Since acquiring Spicewood Beach, LCRA has replaced the entire water system, purchased two additional systems in the area, and constructed interconnects to those systems.
