Background The system collects wastewater from Tahitian Village homes and conveys it to the City of Bastrop treatment system. Through a February 2000 agreement with the City of Bastrop and Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District No. 2, LCRA constructed a central system to replace individual septic systems. Individual septic systems posed a potential water quality problem for the Colorado River because tight clay soils on small lots did not allow proper operation of drainage fields.
