Release of Retainage

The following are required by the contract before the withheld retainage can be released to the contractor:

- 1. Completion of the items listed on the project punch list
- 2. Approval by the engineer for LCRA as required under the bond documents
- 3. Approval by the LCRA Board
- 4. Certification by the Texas Water Development Board's executive administrator that the construction work has been completed and performed in a satisfactory manner and in accordance with approved plans and specifications
