

## Highland Lakes Watershed Ordinance Gravel Landscaping Impervious Cover Credit

Gravel landscape beds can function as pervious cover and count as credit to meet impervious cover limits in the Highland Lakes Watershed Ordinance. The Revegetation Options During Drought Conditions technical bulletin notes that "non-vegetated permanent stabilization alternatives may be proposed for review and approval" and rock gravel landscape satisfies this condition.

Criteria to meet gravel landscaping impervious cover credit:

- 1. Minimum gravel size is 3/8-inch diameter and must be clean washed stone. No decomposed granite or any graded material.
- 2. Four-inch minimum depth for rock sizes 1 inch and smaller. For larger river rock, use larger depths.
- 3. Soil scarified to a depth of 3 to 4 inches prior to rock placement.
- 4. Maximum average slope of 5%.
- 5. If used, landscape fabric must be water permeable.
