

The Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) has established rules and regulations to protect park areas for your enjoyment now and in the future.

Please observe the following to ensure a pleasant and safe visit:

- I. Picnicking and camping are allowed only in designated areas on LCRA land.
- 2. Only licensed vehicles are permitted in the parks. ATVs, golf carts and motorized scooters are not allowed.
- 3. Please drink responsibly. Public consumption or display of alcohol is prohibited.
- 4. Campfires are allowed only in designated fire rings or barbecue pits. (At Matagorda Bay Nature Park, no open fires are allowed unless contained in an above-ground device with a spark screen installed covering the fire.)
- 5. Weapons, hunting and trapping are not allowed.
- 6. Possession or discharge of any kind of fireworks or explosives is prohibited.
- 7. Swimming is allowed but not within 50 feet of any boat ramp. Swimming is at your own risk; there are no lifeguards. Portable swimming pools or slip 'n slides are prohibited.
- 8. Protect pets and wildlife by keeping pets on leash in designated camping and picnicking areas; outide designated camping and picnicking areas, pets must be kept under their owner's direct control. Please clean up and properly dispose of all pet waste.
- 9. Respect quiet hours from 10 p.m. 6 a.m.
- 10. Thank you for not littering. Leaving no trace of your visit helps the park remain beautiful and reduces the possibility of human/animal conflicts.
