Notice of Application for a Coal Combustion Residuals Registration

Application. Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a new Registration, to authorize the operation and expansion of an existing Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) landfill for the disposal and/or management of CCR at 6549 Power Plant Road, La Grange, 78945, in Fayette County. TCEQ received the application on January 24, 2022. The executive director has completed the administrative and technical review of the application and prepared a draft registration. The draft registration, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate the CCR landfill. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this registration, if issued, meets all the statutory and regulatory requirements. The registration application and subsequent modifications, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft registration are available for viewing and copying at the Fayette Public Library, 855 S. Public Comment/Public Meeting. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting on this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ holds a public meeting if the executive director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing. After the deadline for submitting public comments, the executive director will consider all timely public comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material or significant public comments. The comment period will end 30 days after this notice is published. The comment period will be extended to the close of any public meeting.

Executive Director Action. The executive director may issue final approval of the application. If the executive director acts on the application, the Office of the Chief Clerk shall mail or otherwise transmit notice of the action and an explanation of the opportunity to file a motion to overturn the executive director's decision to the applicant, persons who requested to be on the mailing list for this registration, who submitted comments during the public comment period, and the Office of the Public Interest Counsel.
