## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE ENERGY OPERATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY

Austin, Texas May 21, 2019

Pursuant to notice posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Energy Operations Committee (committee) of the Board of Directors (Board) of the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) convened in a meeting at 11:38 a.m. Tuesday, May 21, 2019, in the Board Room of the Hancock Building, at the principal office of LCRA, 3700 Lake Austin Blvd., Austin, Travis County, Texas. The meeting was open to the public, and the following committee members were present, constituting a quorum:

Chair Lewis convened the meeting at 11:38 a.m. and welcomed the following representatives of LCRA's wholesale electric customers: Bridget Headrick, chief of staff for Pedernales Electric Cooperative (PEC); David Thompson, vice president of Markets for PEC; and Lowell Ogle, assistant city manager of Public Utilities for the City of Brenham. Ogle and Thompson also serve as president and vice president of the Rates and Resources Council (RRC), respectively. The RRC membership consists of representatives of the majority of LCRA's wholesale electric customers.

There were no public comments on general topics within the committee's area of oversight during this meeting.

The committee heard comments from David Thompson and Lowell Ogle. Thompson, on behalf of the RRC, addressed the committee regarding the proposed fiscal year 2020 LCRA business plan. [The LCRA Board considered and approved the FY 2020 business and

capital plans as Item 11 at its May 22 meeting]. Thompson also commented on LCRA's efforts to support wholesale electric customers' goals, especially those relating to the procurement of renewable energy, economic development discount options and summer preparedness. Thompson thanked LCRA staff and leadership and the Board for their continued commitment to lowering controllable costs and providing expanded options and support to customers.

Ogle addressed the committee and expressed appreciation for LCRA's increased transparency and efforts to work with the RRC.
