

LCRA Firm Inventory, Commitments and Demand (acre-feet per year)




Short History of the Board Reserve

- 1989 50,000 acre-feet first set aside for 10-county statutory district
- 1999 Reserve extended to cover 33-county water service area
- 2003 Reserve extended to two additional counties
- 2019 Reserve reduced by 5,000 acre-feet to the current commitment of 45,000 acre-feet
