MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE WATER OPERATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY

Austin, Texas Sept. 23, 2020

Pursuant to notice posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Water Operations Committee (committee) of the Board of Directors (Board) of the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) convened in a meeting at 11:30 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 23, 2020, in the Board Room of the Hancock Building, at the principal office of LCRA, 3700 Lake Austin Blvd., Austin, Travis County, Texas. The meeting was open to the public, and the following committee members were present, constituting a quorum:

Due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, and in accordance with the governor's disaster declaration and subsequent temporary suspension of certain provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the public was not allowed to attend this meeting in person but had access to the open session portions of this meeting via livestream and via telephone for comment.

Chair Martine convened the meeting at 11:30 a.m.

David Lindsay, vice president of Technical Research for the Central Texas Water Coalition, addressed the committee and expressed concerns about recent low inflows into the Highland Lakes.

<u>20-02</u> Upon motion by Director Berger, seconded by LCRA Board Chair Timmerman, the committee unanimously approved the minutes of its last meeting, held Jan. 21, 2020, as presented.

Chief Meteorologist Bob Rose presented a weather briefing, including climate statistics for summer 2020, information on drought conditions, and a weather forecast and outlook for fall and winter 2020.

General Manager Phil Wilson shared remarks honoring the memory of Haskell Simon for his longstanding service in the interest of the Colorado River basin.

Vice President of Water Operations Kelly Payne presented an update on basin and water supply conditions, including inflows to the Highland Lakes relative to historic inflows, and drought information. Executive Vice President of Water John B. Hofmann and Payne responded to questions from the Board regarding inflows.

Hofmann and Vice President of Water Resources Monica Masters gave a presentation on LCRA water supply projects underway or recently completed, potential new water supply strategies, and water supply resource planning.

Chair Martine declared the meeting to be in executive session at 1:44 p.m., pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code (Open Meetings Act). Executive session ended, and Chair Timmerman declared the meeting to be in public session at 2:01 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 2:01 p.m.
