Pursuant to the rules of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“Commission”), please find enclosed a copy of the application of Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (“Oncor”) and LCRA Transmission Services Corporation (“LCRA TSC”) to Amend their Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for the Proposed North McCamey to Sand Lake 345 kilovolt (“kV”) Transmission Line Project (“Proposed Transmission Line Project”), including the Environmental Assessment (“EA”) attached thereto, filed at the Commission on June 22, 2023, in Commission Docket No. 55121.

This docket concerns Oncor’s and LCRA TSC’s request for approval to install a new 345 kV transmission line between LCRA TSC’s existing North McCamey Station in Upton County, Texas, and Oncor’s existing Sand Lake Station in Ward County, Texas. The North McCamey Station is located approximately 0.6 mile north of the city of McCamey and northwest of the intersection of United States Highway (“US”) 67 and US 385, and the Sand Lake Station is located approximately 6 miles northeast of the city of Pecos on the northwest side of Farm-to-Market Road 3398. The estimated cost range of this project is \$335,863,000 to \$414,878,000. The EA provides a detailed description of the data gathered and analyzed by Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company Inc. (Burns & McDonnell), a consulting firm retained by Oncor and LCRA TSC for the Proposed Transmission Line Project.
