



Irrigation Technology Rebate Application

LCRA offers rebates for the purchase of specific irrigation equipment that increases the efficiency of automatic sprinkler systems. Rebates are available for three irrigation technology equipment upgrades: rain and freeze sensors, soil moisture sensors, and pressure-reducing heads and nozzles. The maximum rebate available is \$1,270 per system. To apply for the rebate:

- (1) Have a licensed irrigator, your water provider, or an LCRA representative assess your irrigation system. Or do it yourself. If upgrades are recommended as part of the evaluation, property owners must install the equipment or hire a licensed irrigator to install the equipment. Rebates are available for the purchase of equipment, not labor or taxes.
- (2) After upgrading your sprinkler system, complete an [IRS W-9 form](#) (available at www.watersmart.org) and this rebate application form. Submit both forms and a copy of the receipts for equipment to LCRA by email to brett.briant@lcra.org or mail to:

- (3) LCRA will contact you after receiving the completed application to schedule an inspection.
- (4) LCRA will mail a rebate check once the inspection is complete and system upgrades are confirmed to be in good working order.

- LCRA and its firm water customers have not and do not make any representations, warranties or promises, either express or implied, with respect to any irrigation equipment, including but not limited to any warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, or quality, reliability, durability, water savings or compatibility with your existing irrigation system.
- I understand that if I provide false information on this application or fail to comply with the terms of this application, LCRA is entitled to a reimbursement of the rebate amount, plus any costs associated with recovering such sums.
